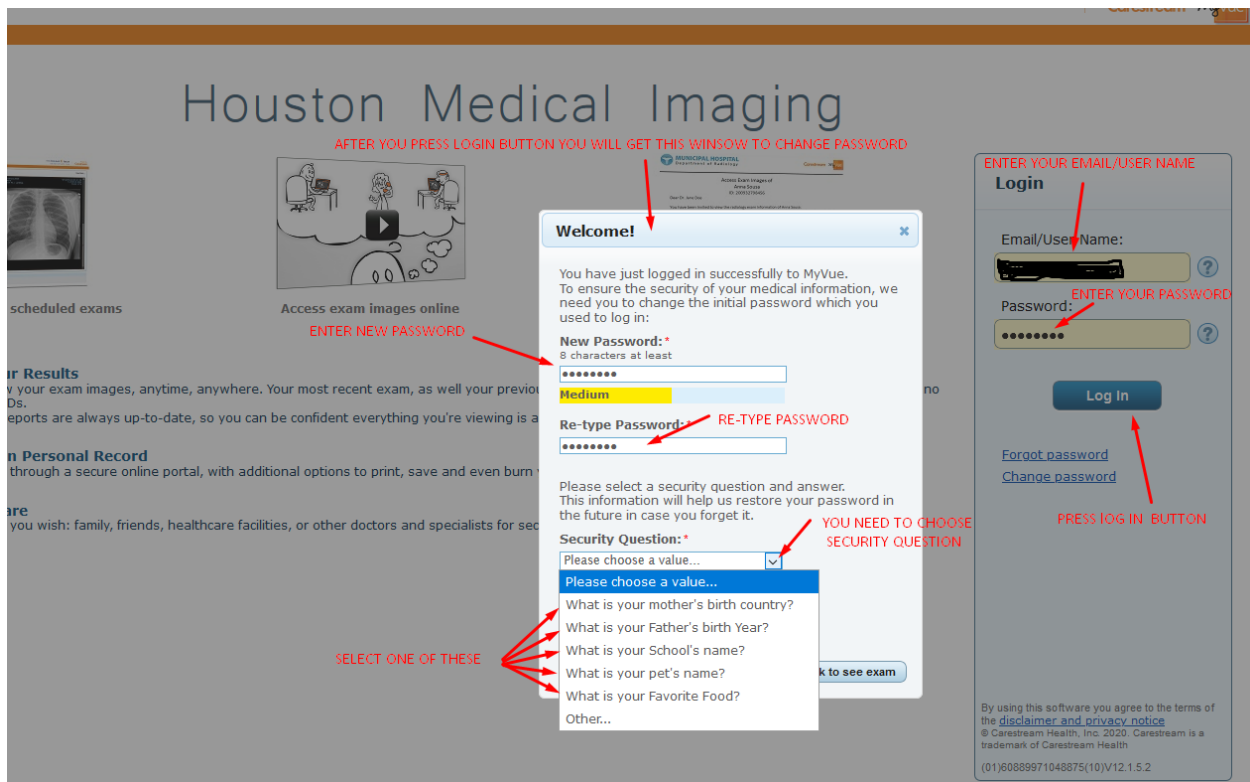

You will then be asked to select one of the Security Questions and once you provide an answer, please press the "Click to see exam" button (shown in picture below).

## How to Save Exam

If you need to save your exam, please click on the option “Save exam” (see picture below) and upon clicking, two additional windows with information will appear. The first window will let you know that the portal is preparing the exam selected to download. The second window will require you to choose the option “Save File” and then click on the “OK” button to save your exam to your PC.

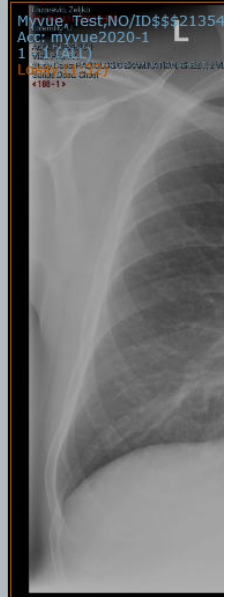
